

Procedure for CT / MR

<p>1. Receive the Doctor's Prescription</p>	<p>After the doctor orders the CT/MR examination, you need to pay at least one day before the scan by 18.00pm; otherwise the system will automatically cancel your appointment. For in-patients, the examination expense will be added to their inpatient bills.</p> <p>If the patient has taken a CT/MR examination from another hospital, please bring the result to our hospital for comparison on the day of examination.</p> <p>Please prepare 1.5 liter of drinking water on the day for examination, and drink it under the supervision of the nurse after the injection of contrast medium before the examination.</p>
<p>2. Register</p>	<p>Please go to the front desk of the Medical Imaging Department at the scheduled time, and register with your appointment form and examination form. Please inform the front desk in advance if you need to change your test time due to urgent changes: 020-87343214.</p> <p>The place for registration is at the front desk of Medical Imaging Department on the 4th floor of the No.1 Building or the 2nd floor of the No.2 Building.</p> <p>The time indicated on the appointment form is the time for registration. Please wait for your turn after registration.</p> <p>The patient will receive a barcode as the order number for injection and examination. The patient also needs to bring the barcode with him/her when he/she comes for the result.</p>
<p>3. Get Injection</p>	<p>The nurse will call the patient after he/she registers at the front desk for an injection. Please wait in the lobby until the nurse calls the patient's number.</p> <p>If the patient has allergies or special medical records, please inform the injection nurse in advance.</p> <p>After the injection, please wait in the lobby for examination and do not tamper with the vein detained needle.</p> <p>If the patient is scheduled for pelvic CT test, please drink water under the nurse's guidance and he/she must refrain from urinating until the CT test is over.</p> <p>Do not wear any jewelry or clothes with metal decorations, or bring with you any metal products (e.g. electronic card) when you enter the test room.</p>
<p>4. Examination</p>	<p>Critically ill patients or pediatric patients should be accompanied by their family, who should wear protective clothing under the supervision of the doctors/nurses during the CT test.</p>

	<p>During the test, please follow the technician's instructions: the technician will put you in a fixed position, please remain still. The technician will also tell you to hold your breath for parts of the examination.</p>
	<p>Please wait in the lounge area for 15-30 minutes after the CT test, to ensure that there is no uncomfortable feeling.</p>
	<p>Please drink as much water as possible 2-3 days after the test, in order to get rid of the contrast medium.</p>
<p>5. Get the report</p>	<p>Please keep all the related forms and receipts safe until you get the CT test result. Between 2 working days to one month after the test, you can get the report from the automatic printing machine in the corridor connecting the No.1 and No.2 Buildings (2nd Floor), with your appointment form or your patient card.</p>
