

Procedure for PET-CT

1. Registration: please register at the front desk of Nuclear Medicine Department at the appointment time.
2. Preparations for injection: In the preparation room, blood glucose levels will be tested, and 600ml iodinated contrast medium will be taken orally by the patient. An iodine allergy test will be carried out for enhanced CT patient.
3. Intravenous injection: contrast medium will be injected into the patient in the PET-CT injection window.
4. Drug metabolism: please rest in the PET-CT lounge for 40-90 minutes. Try to be relaxed and keep warm, while avoid watching videos and limit talking.
5. Preparation for the test: drink 600-800ml water, empty your bladder, change to test clothes and slippers. Guidance will then be provided via interphone.
6. Imaging: lie on your back and keep still for the duration of the test. The test usually takes around 15-30 minutes.
7. After the test: after notice from the doctor/nurse, patient can leave via the special elevator.
8. Getting the report: please get your PET-CT report at the front desk of the Department of Nuclear Medicine on 4th

Floor of No. 2 Building, after 10:00 AM on the third working day of your test.
